Commitment

The ZINAFE shall:

- Provide a safe environment and promote a safe culture in which to fellowship by appointing a National Safeguarding Representative (NSR), Branch Safeguarding
 Officers (BSO) and Guild Safeguarding Officers (GSO) [Ref.1].
- Ensure that all those who are authorised to work with children and vulnerable adults are appropriately recruited.
- Facilitate the provision of adequate training and necessary support.
- Take the necessary steps to all concerns and allegations of abuse [Ref.2] [Ref.3].
- Support victims/survivors of abuse by offering or arranging sensitive and informed pastoral care.
- Support anyone who is the subject of concerns or allegations of abuse by offering or arranging sensitive and informed pastoral care
- Take the necessary steps against anyone suspected of posing a posing present risk to others.
